Marco Invernizzi Workshop & Demonstration - To be held on 20 November at the Garden Works trailer-classroom. The address is 4290 Blenkinsop, Victoria.

The workshop is from 09:00 to 12:00. The cost is \$85.00 and this includes a tree (there is a choice between a Kingsville Boxwood or a Hinoki Cypress), and the artistic interpretation of Marco Invernizzi. There is space for 10 Members and the sign-up sheet will be at the November meeting. Silent observers are free as usual and it is open to all Club Members. The Demonstration (no tree available yet) will be from 1:30 to 4:30 at the same place, and is open and free to all Club Members.

We are lucky that we can share the expenses of this international bonsai artist with Seattle, in order to keep the cost of the workshop reasonable. For your information, \$50.00 from the workshop fees is to cover the tree; and \$35.00 to cover part of the artist fees and expenses.

Italian artist Marco Invernizzi is a talented young bonsai artist who has quickly become one of the most sought-after artists in the western world. Marco started his bonsai education under the tutelage of Salvatore Liporace. Later, Marco traveled to Japan and undertook a 3-year apprenticeship with Mr. Masahiko Kimura.

Marco's work has received many accolades, including several UBI awards, and his articles and photos of his bonsai work have appeared in several American and European magazines. Marco works full-time as a bonsai artist and now travels the world doing professional work for collectors, nurseries, clubs and organizations. In 2003 Marco published his first book, published in Italian, describing his adventures in moving to Japan and pursuing bonsai.



Marco, in this visit to the West will be in San Francisco, Victoria, Seattle and Sacramento.
