1:00 pm – Arrive at Japan Bonsai, Surrey. Tak is once again generously providing a BBQ lunch. We will have plenty of time to browse among Tak's huge selection of indoor and outdoor bonsai and pre-bonsai as well as pots, tools, soil mixes, etc.

3:50 pm -- leave to catch the 5:00 pm ferry back and return to the meeting place at approximately 7:15 pm


